

Financial Report for St. Martha School Parent Council
2013/2014

The 2011/12 St. Martha School Parent Council began with a balance of \$32,943.88 at ATB Financial.

We paid \$14,572.95 for the purchase of iPads and a cart for Division II, which were ordered in the 2012.2013 school year.

Our fundraising efforts of a walk/run-a-thon raised a net profit of \$22,590.57.

We donated \$1,000.00 to Mr. Simmons' Martha's Madness Volleyball Tournament.

We supplemented \$147.54 worth of food for the teachers' lunch for the November Parent-Teacher interviews.

We purchased the annual membership for the library's Renaissance Learning program at a cost of \$2,299.43.

We bought a reflective STOP sign for \$235.48 to increase the safety of our crossing guards and students during the winter months.

We hosted a family dance in April with profits of \$2,297.45.

We support Sports Day by providing \$2,000.00 towards t-shirts for students, staff and volunteers.

We continued with our Kanga Pouch program for Division One. We charge \$10.00 to each family, but donate Kanga Pouches to families in need.

We close the 2013/2014 year with a balance of \$37,463.08. These funds will be used to purchase iPads and accessories for EEP, Kindergarten and Division I teachers to use in their classrooms next year.
